

<u>Corridor I - Helsinki to Warsaw</u> National E67 road "Via Baltica" and E75 train line.

<u>Corridor II – Berlin to Moscow</u> National E30 road (A2 highway - underconstruction) and E20 and CE20 train lines.

<u>Corridor VI -Gdańsk to Ostrawa</u> A1 highway – under construction and E65 train line (Centralna Magistrala Kolejowa).






