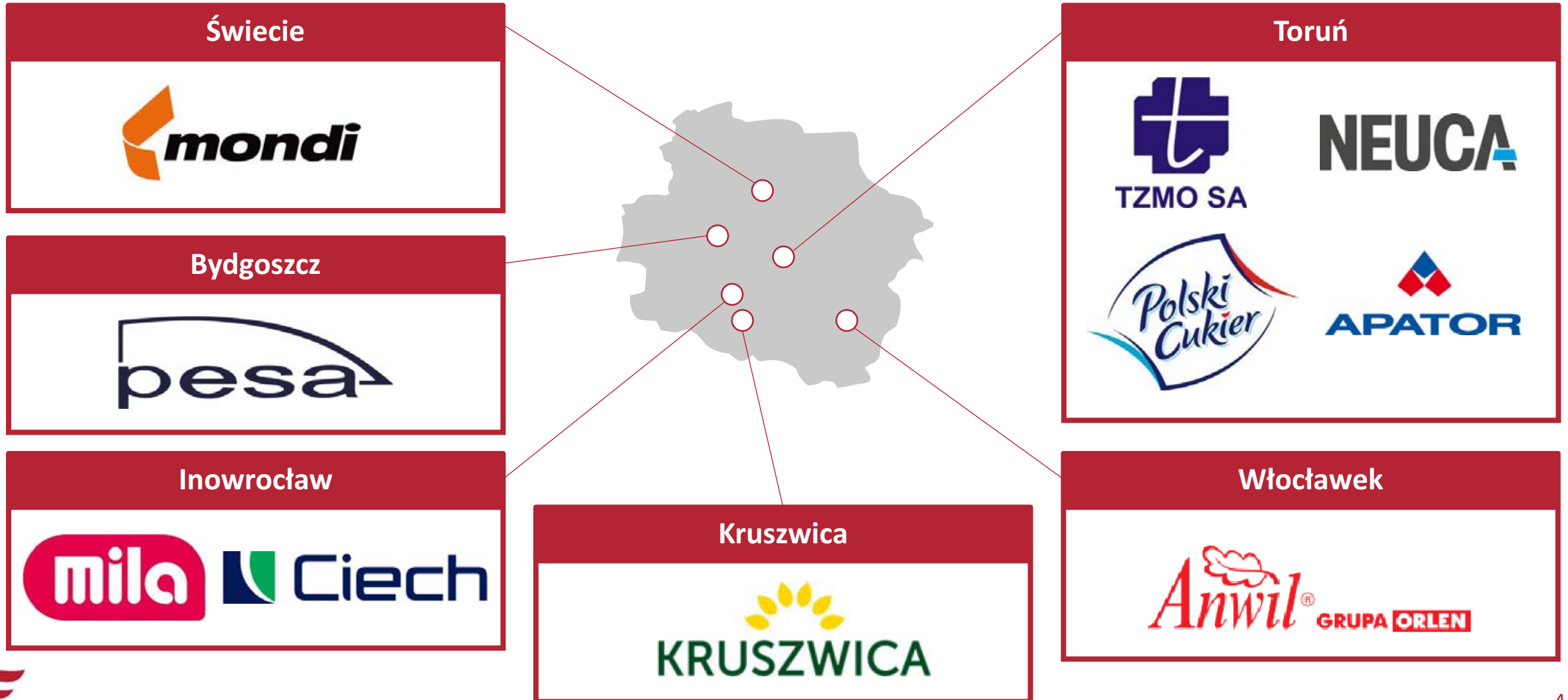

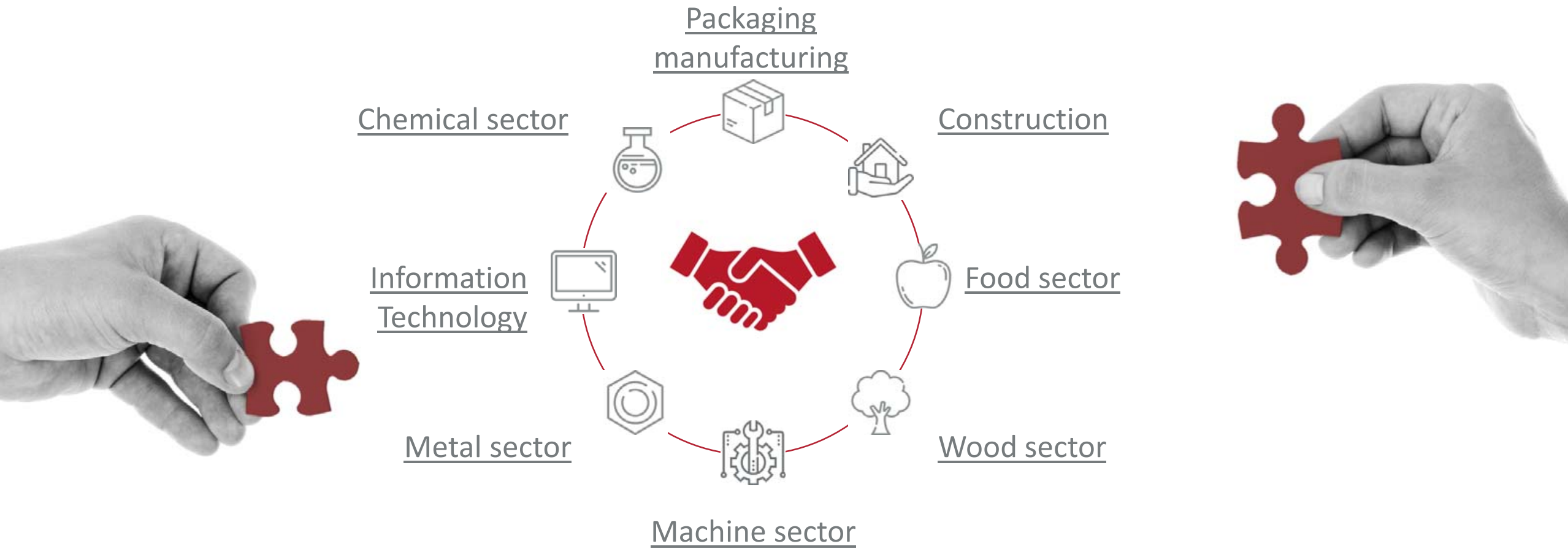


The Pomeranian Special Economic Zone

It includes **35 subzones** located in 5 voivodships. The total area of zonal areas is **2246.2929 ha**, out of which **564.1241 ha** are areas in the Pomeranian voivodship, 880.213 ha in the Kuyavian-Pomeranian voivodship, 70.6768 ha in the Wielkopolskie voivodship, while 637.2176 ha is located in the Zachodniopomorskie voivodship, while 94,0614 ha is located in the Lubelskie province.

The SEZ is a convenient location for investment - by the main transport routes and near international airports and seaports.







Bydgoszcz - international regular passenger traffic, charters and a military air base

Kuyavian-Pomeranian - attractive location by the A1 motorway

The main road in the region is the A1 motorway running from north to south of the country, also known as the Amber Highway. There are also two expressways in the region - S5 and S10. The international route in the Kuyavian-Pomeranian voivodship is the European route E75, running from Vardø in Norway to Sitia in Crete, Greece.



Bydgoszcz, Toruń - the main railway junctions of the voivodship

The Kuyavian-Pomeranian voivodship is in the top five voivodships in terms of the railway network density. The network is to be further improved according to the National Railway Programme.
