



This zone is located in 9 subzones with separate and individual investment regions. The total area is **1049.18 ha**. **136 permits for running a business** were granted in TSSE EURO-PARK WISŁOSAN so far. 84 companies have already started investing activities. Entrepreneurs have created nearly **13,000 new jobs** so far. Capital expenditures in the Zone exceeded PLN 2 billion.


Starachowice Special Economic Zone

The area of the zone is **707.108** ha. In total, **176** business permits were issued in SEZ "Starachowice", which resulted in investments in the amount of PLN **2532 million** and **8289** work places. The zone offers areas with industrial facilities - production halls, warehouse and office buildings - as well as plots ready for development.

Masłów Airport (charter flights) - currently the airport handles irregular, sports and business flights. The increase of its function and significance will take place after expansion and modernization.

Concept of construction of Kielce Regional Airport (regional, international, cargo flights) - construction of an airport from scratch (distance of about 25 km south of Kielce) will improve transport accessibility to Kielce Trade EXPO center and spas and tourist destinations.

Świętokrzyskie – access to significant transport corridors

There are eight national roads crossing the region, with a total length of 731.876 km. The region is crossed by two express roads of significant importance - No. 7 in the north-south direction and road No. 74 in the west-east direction, their expansion is planned.





Railway network

There are 10 sections of railway lines with a total length of 724.9 km across the area of the Świętokrzyskie Voivodeship, of which 270 km are national lines, including line No. 8: Warsaw - Radom - Kielce - Krakow. The most important for the voivodship's economy are railway junctions in Kielce and Skarżysko Kamienna, station in Sędziszów and stations servicing the mining industry and related processing: Rykoszyn, Sitkówka-Nowiny, Małogoszcz and Ożarów




