
WHAT IS FASHION WEEK?

The First Fashion Week in Moscow took place in 1994 under support of Moscow Government. It was considered to be the start of fashion industry in Russia.



GOVERNMENT SUPPORT



Built in the 18th century, it has been totally altered inside providing the highest level of services and facilities that are seen as vital for arranging exhibitions and various events.






VENUE






There are numerous business opportunities inside MFW in both b2b and b2c segments.
