## The military situation in Ukraine is of significant importance

The export of Polish military product has been growing fast in last 10 years (+18,9% CAGR). However, in 2022, due to the conflict in Ukraine, exports have grown 7 fold to \$931,12 m. **Value of Polish export:** \$27.25 m. (2012)

### Main Polish military producer

Polska Grupa Zbrojeniowa (PGZ) is one of the largest manufacturers of military equipment in Europe. While more than 50 smaller manufacturers are associated within the Group, the Group additionally holds shares in 32 other companies.

### **Central localization**

Poland is located in the center of Europe and is part of NATO



### Access to well educated workforce



Military University of Technology (WAT) – both a military and civilian university dedicated to the development of security and defense technologies, in the academic year 2022/23 it provides education for over 7,500 students. Its graduates are a valuable experts for entire Polish defense industry.

### Poland as a logistic hub



Since the outbreak of war in Ukraine, Poland, as its neighbour, has become the logistics hub ensuring supplies to Ukraine. The border airport in Rzeszow is a crucial point on the map and the Podkarpacie region is playing a key logistics role for military supplies to Ukraine.

## **DID YOU KNOW THAT**

### A modular weapon for the 21st century

The Polish MSBS-5.56 "Grot" weapon is produced in the "Łucznik" factory in Radom. Their latest product, a modular design based on the requirements of today's military forces, which has already proved to be a versatile and effective weapon.

The carbine is currently being used in the conflict in Ukraine, where it is considered to be one of the best weapons in the field of combat, helping Ukraine to protect its independence.

### FlyEye: sky-high innovation for providing security

The mini UAV system "FlyEye", developed by Flytronic (part of the Polish WB Group), an advanced close-range unmanned aerial platform, designed for observation and data collection, is part of NSPA's (NATO's Support and Procurement Agency) range of products.

## Safety in the sky and on the ground thanks to Polish defense products

The portable anti-aircraft missile system "Piorun", manufactured by the Polish company "Mesko", has proven to be an effective anti-aircraft weapon, providing protection against airborne threats.

Another example of Polish defense products is the self-propelled tracked gun-howitzer "AHS Krab". Produced by a Polish state owned company "Huta Stalowa Wola (HSW)" the vehicle is aimed to effectively provide an advantage on the battlefield.

From almost the first moments of the invasion of Ukraine, when Polish weapons were delivered there, they have proved their usefulness in military operations, supporting national defense.
