








Significant importance of military situation in Ukraine

The export of Polish military product has been growing fast in last 10 years (+18,9% CAGR). In 2023, export has grown to 1059.70 m. USD.

Main Polish military producer

Polska Grupa Zbrojeniowa (PGZ) is one of the largest defense concerns in Europe. More than 50 smaller producers are associated within the Group, and the Group additionally holds shares in 32 other companies.

Access to highly educated workforce



Military University of Technology - both a military and civilian university dedicated to the development of security and defense technologies, in the academic year 2022/23 provides education for over 7,500 students. Its graduates often are a valuable experts for entire Polish defense industry.

Poland as the logistic hub



Since the outbreak of the conflict in Ukraine, Poland, as a neighbor of Ukraine, has become a key country and a logistics hub ensuring supplies to this country. The border airport next to the city of RzeszOw is an important point on the map and the Podkarpacie region plays a key logistic role for military supplies to Ukraine.

Modular firearm of the 21st century



The Polish MSBS-5.56 "Grot" carbine is the latest design produced by the Polish company Fabryka Broni "ŁUCZNIK" - Radom. The modular design based on the requirements of the modern battlefield make it considered a versatile and effective weapon. The carbine is currently being tested in combat in the conflict in Ukraine, where it is considered one of the best shooting weapons helping this country to protect its independence.



FlyEye: sky-high innovation for providing security

The aircraft system "FlyEye", developed by Flytronic (part of the Polish WB Group), an advanced military surveillance drone, is offered by NSPA, i.e. NATO Support and Procurement Agency – the main logistics and procurement agency of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation.



The portable anti-aircraft missile system "Piorun", manufactured by the Polish company Mesko, has proven to be an effective anti-aircraft weapon, providing protection against airborne threats.



Another example of Polish defense product is self-propelled tracked gun-howitzer "AHS Krab". Produced by Polish state company Huta Stalowa Wola (HSW) vehicle is aimed to effectively provide an advantage on the battlefield.


