

Europe's top talents



According to the *IT Competitiveness Index**, in the "Talent" component Poland is number 5 out of all the rated countries. In addition, Poland also ranked 5th in the IT infrastructure, 9th in the Economic Environment and 8th in Business Environment.



4th Most Favoured Offshore CX Delivery Location

Poland is the only European nearshore location in the list, which has been ranked in the top 5 for the fourth year running.

Studies related to the ICT sector have shown an increase in the number of students for another consecutive year. In the 2022/2023 academic year, more than 70,000 people studied these majors.



The most dynamic development of the digital economy


According to PwC forecasts, e-commerce to consumers alone will reach more than €42 billion in Poland by 2027. Such a fast growth rate of e-commerce value puts Poland at the forefront of countries that are the most dynamically developing the digital part of their economy.



The ICT market is growing in strength

The value of Poland's ICT exports in 2023 was \$16.85 bn, compared to \$13.48 bn in 2022 and \$11.58 bn in 2021.

The export of ICT services in 2023 amounted to 15,5% of the total export of services from Poland



Poland is gaining more and more importance as a leader in the field of IT in Central and Eastern Europe. Investments by global players such as Google, Amazon, Microsoft and Data4 in data centers in Poland confirm the country's attractiveness for the technology industry.

Poland ranks 10th in Top 10 Smartest Countries Based on Reading, Math and Science according to OECD.





Competence in English – no problem!

The majority of Polish programmers boast higher education. In addition, Poles have an excellent command of English (598 points in the English Proficiency Index), which places us 13th out of 113 ranking countries.

An environment of development for programmers

Poland has the largest pool of technology talent in Europe, with approximately 600,000 programmers working here, accounting for more than 25% of the entire development community in CEE.

A strategic hub for the BSS sector

More than 85% of all IT professionals in Poland are employed in one of the seven largest IT hubs. Three Polish cities, Warsaw, Krakow and Wroclaw, are the most recognized globally as IT/ICT basins.



Krakow - the royal city for start-ups

Krakow is one of the most rapidly growing start-up centers, with 60,000 IT professionals and more than 500 technology companies. Every year Krakow's talent pool grows by 10%, increasing 10-fold in the past 25 years.



We have the best programmers

Poland maintains its strong position in the top three countries with the best programmers in the world. In the Emerging Europe – Future of IT 2023 Report, Poland was also ranked 1st in the evaluation of the talent availability factor.



More and more software companies

There are currently more than 50,000 IT companies in Poland. This includes more than 1,300 software development companies, a number that's been increasing by about 10% each year.
