





Main export destinations in 2024






WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT

A Leader in Household Appliance production

According to APPLiA, Poland is still the leader in household appliance production across Europe. The 35 Polish factories account for about 40% of the volume of production of large household appliances across the European Union. The industry employs over 100k people in Poland.

Digital transformation of mining industry

Alongside innovative techniquess and machinery, Polish mining industry is gradually undergoing a transformation as part of the Mining 4.0 movement. The international Mine.io programme, financed as part of the "European Union's Horizon Europe research and innovation programme", is meant to thoroughly transform the industry in the sectors of mining, processing plants and metallurgy.

Evolving agricultural sector

Poland's Strategic Plan for 2023-2027 was prepared with the sustainable development of farms, the processing sector and the improvement of living and working conditions in rural areas in mind. It will support the protection of water, soil, air and biodiversity and promote the production and use of sustainable energy. It will also focus on small farmers and animal welfare.

According to European Commission, Over 127 000 persons will benefit from advice, training or knowledge exchange or participate in European Innovation Partnership Operational Groups.

Strong base for development of agritech

The Polish agri-food sector achieved record exports in 2024, with revenues rising 2.7% year-on-year to €53.5 billion, according to a report by the National Support Centre for Agriculture. This robust sector provides a strong local base for an innovative ecoystem of innovative startups such as Nirby, Ribes Technologies, hydroponic startup Hydropolis, nutrition startup Hipromine or specialised sensor producer Cropler, to name a few

Robots at work



Poland, alongside the rest of Europe, is catching up on the robotisation of the workplace. IN Q2 2023, 2685 new robots were installed in Poland. With over 24 800 units of active operating robots (a 9& year-over-year increase), the country ranks 18th in the world in terms of the number of installations



Polish haul trucks in the UK

At the end of 2024 KGHM ZANAM S.A. received an order from British Gypsum for its HT20 haultrucks, which will be delivered to the British underground gypsum mines in 2025.



Large fairs across the country

There were 121 fairs across 13 Polish cities in 2023, with Poznan leading the way with the greatest number of industry fairs. Some of the largest fairs pertinent to machines & appliances industry include AGROSHOW, ENEX ITM Industry Europe or Agrotech, an International Fair of Agricultural Techniques that will celebrate its 30th anniversary in 2025. The Agrotech's 2024 edition saw 520 companies from 17 countries showcase in Kielce its products to over 71 000 visitors.

The Polish Chamber of Commerce of Agricultural Machines - PIGMIUR

The Polish Chamber of Commerce of Agricultural Machines and Facilities was established in 1998. Currently, more than 152 companies from the sector are the members of the Chamber, including some of the the largest Polish producers and distributors of machines and representatives of the global brands of agricultural machines and appliances. The main objective of PIGMIUR is improving conditions in which companies from the agricultural machines and appliances sector operate.



Established in 2005, Digital Poland Association is an industry employers' organization, a non-profit organization bringing together the largest companies from the consumer electronics and IT operating in Poland, including both manufacturers, importers and distributors of electrical and electronic equipment.

Mining Chamber of Industry and Commerce

The Polish Mining Chamber of Industry and Commerce (GIPH) is an association of business entities, such as manufacturers of coal and lignite, manufacturers of machinery and equipment for the mining industry, operators of research and development facilities, as well as companies providing services to the mining industry. It has been aiding the sector for over 33 years.
