

Rapidly developing sector


In years 2013-2023, the average growth (compound annual growth rate, CAGR) was about 15.10%. With over 1000 companies and ca. 50,000 employes in 2024, as well as approximately 25,000 boats produced annually, this sector has undergone rapid development since 2013.

Poland is also the 2nd after the US exporter of yachts worldwide, ahead of China, Mexico and Italy

Ranked first in the EU in terms of the value of yacht exports in 2023:

1.	Poland	\$716.6 mln
2.	Italy	\$133.7 mln
3.	Lithuania	\$44.7 mln
4.	Portugal	\$38.3 mln
5.	Germany	\$31.9 mln

Ideal for sailing and boating

Poland's 440 km of coastline, over 7,000 lakes and 631 marinas make it an ideal country for boating enthusiasts.



Chosen by the best

You may be surprised to learn that among the fans of Polish yachts you will find the international tennis superstar Rafael Nadal (who is the proud owner of a luxury 80 Sunreef Power yacht), double FI® World Champion Fernando Alonso, pop singer Julio Iglesias and the former FI® World Champion Nico Rosberg (an ambasador for Sunreef Yachts Eco line of catamarans). Both yachts were manufactured in Gdańsk.



Innovation matched by style

Galeon, the Polish yacht manufacturer, is appreciated for their innovative solutions such as the rotating cockpit sofa and 'Beach Mode' drop-down sides, while Conrad Shipyard's 133' Viatoris won an award at the World Superyacht Awards in London. The Polish yacht builders were also involved in such projects as the polar vessel "National Geographic Resolution" or Cable Layer "Nexans Aurora". Meanwhile Sunreef Yachts are working on the Sunreef 43M Eco, which is set to become the world's largest electric catamaran once delivered.
